PARENT: We like it; we think it's a nice campus. I think it's interesting because our son will be able to meet boys from all over the United States.

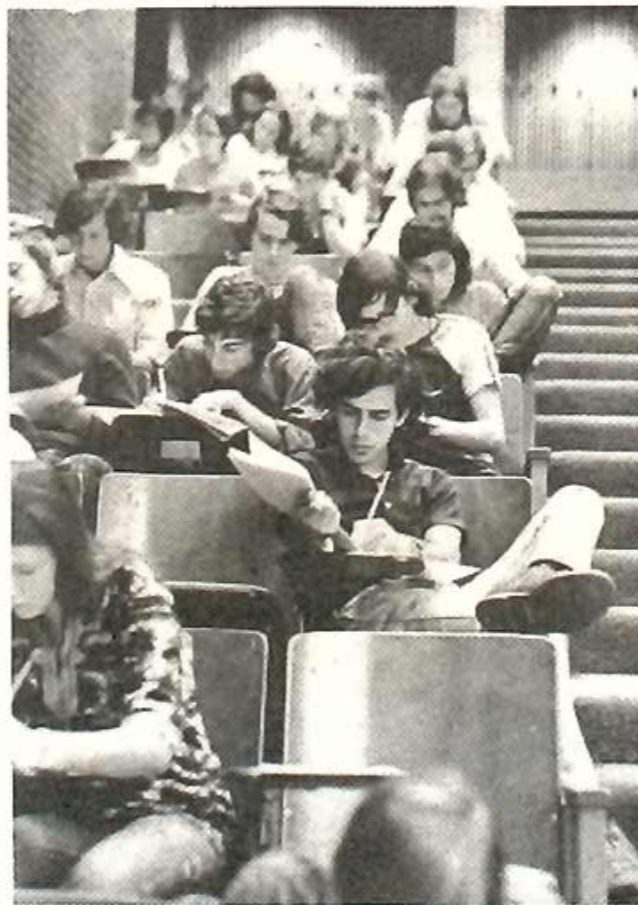
STUDENT: It's alright. Everybody's pretty loose.
