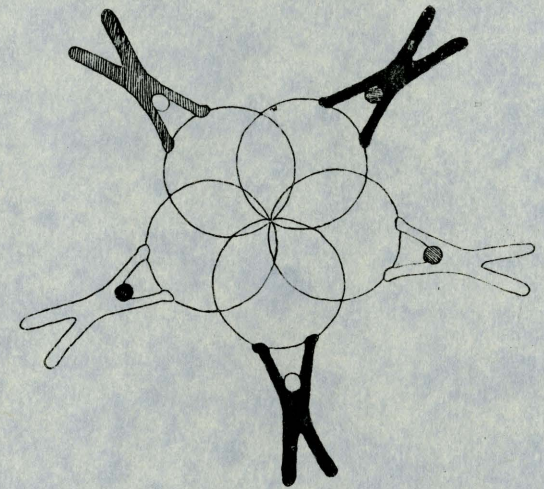
Adelante- Adelante is a student organization that works to raise awareness about issues that impact the Latino and Hispanic community at Macalester College.

Asian Student Alliance- ASA was created to examine and promote the needs of the Asian/Asian American and Pacific Islander community as it relates to Macalester College and the community at large.

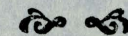
Bridges- Bridges educates the Macalester community about issues and concerns that affect the Bi-racial, Multi-racial, cross-cultural, and transracial adoptee community
